Introduction

There are 648 'letters' within Accession 1156 Item C 1. This number is made up of Letters (453), Memoranda (156), Departmental Orders (28), General Orders (7), Circulars (3) and General Duties (1).

How to Use the Index Numbers

The pages of the Letter Book are numbered, but these numbers are not required in order to find correspondence.

Most of the letters are numbered: the first commencing at 1. For reason unknown 116 of the letters scattered through the Letter Book were not numbered (many being memoranda and including a cancelled letter), but on nearly all occasions when numbering recommences it is evident the un-numbered letters have been 'counted' as though they were numbered (see below).

However some errors were made: 4 numbers were missed and 4 were double counted.

Three letters appear twice. On their first entry the duplicates appear out of their correct numerical and date sequence — they are dated in August, although immediately preceded by letters dated in July. After the entry of the three duplicates, the numbers resume appropriately at the proper July date. The three duplicate letters are written in subsequently at their proper August date. This suggests that the Letter Book was made up at intervals (at least at times) rather than on a more frequent basis.

In this Index un-numbered letters are given an alphabetic suffix. On this basis the actual Letter Book sequence (showing the duplicated, extra and missing letters) is as follows:

Convicts [in *italics*] may have been employed by Government at some time and therefore be shown both in normal type as well as italics.

'nt' (not transported) against a name shows the person appears to be a convict, but one who does not appear in the lists of transportees, even though the Letters show an RN.

An absence of initials or RN means identification to be uncertain without further inquiry.

Note: addressee names are not listed in this Index.
