Introduction

There are 1588 letters, Circulars and Memoranda within Accession 1156 Item C 37.

Throughout the Indexes, names marked with * are mentioned in Barker, D J (2000), *Warders and Gaolers: A Dictionary of WA Prison Officers 1829-1879*, (Privately printed).

Sixteen of the C 37 entries are designated as Memoranda, twenty-eight as Circulars and five as Circular/Memoranda (see page). The basis for the categorisation/differentiation of most of these items is not apparent.

Twenty-two letters, either complete or partially entered were cancelled or marked error. These are listed on page 19.

Eighteen of the numbered letters repeat the numbers immediately prior or subsequent. In this Index (though not in the original) these repeat numbers have the prefix 'A' (ie. A705).

The first 1466 letters are numbered sequentially. Towards the end of these numbered letters, codes are also given. After letter number 1466 codes only are used. Virtually all the letters are in strict date sequence and all the letters after number 1466 are dated in 1864. Consequently this Index shows only the day and month of the un-numbered letters, ie. 8 Apr, all being of 1864.

The 1864 letters have two sequences of 5 letters with the same date and three sequences of 4 similarly dated letters. There are two dating anomalies: a letter shown in the Index as 15 Apr appears *after* the only letter for 16 Apr in the original and similarly a letter dated 18 Apr is, in the original, *after* the only letter dated 19 Apr.

Despite these small variations it is not difficult to find any letter required using the 'dates' shown in the Index.

There are over 3000 name entries in Item C 37. Many of the convict names are spelt phonetically (with more than one variant in some cases) rather than being spelt as in the Official Lists of Transported Convicts held at the State Records Office. In addition, errors in the recording of convict Register Numbers (RN) are frequent (especially inversion — eg. 5231 instead of the proper 5321).

Every effort has been made to identify persons correctly and all convicts have (where applicable) been given names with a spelling and RN as in the Official Lists of Transported Convicts.

Some convict names are spelled differently despite having the same RN, and some have more than one surname (as in the Official Lists), but one name or spelling has been used in this Index to ensure all references to the same person appear together.

Some transported convicts received a local sentence and were then given a 'new number' (ie the original RN was not used). Where these numbers are known, both numbers are given, the most recent RN first, the earlier (usually original) RN in square brackets, ie [].

Those locally sentenced and who are not listed in either the Official Lists of Transported Convicts or in Erickson, R & O'Mara, G (1994), *Convicts in Western Australia 1850 — 1887*, UWA Press, Nedlands are shown in the Index by 'LP', for Local Prisoner, the terminology used in the letters.

The Index refers to 'convict/s' rather than 'prisoner/s' throughout. Prisoner is virtually always used throughout the letters, but in this Index 'convict' is substituted for the purposes of brevity.

Many names in the Letters lack initials or given names and idiosyncratic spelling, poor writing and a frequent inversion of Register Numbers adds to identification difficulties.

Both initials and RN [Register Numbers] have been ascribed where possible.

The spelling of convict names follows the 'official passage lists' and the mode of setting out the RN of those with more than one RN is set out in the Introduction.

A query against an RN shows uncertainty. Where possible the more likely RN has been ascribed. LP indicates Local Prisoner, a person not transported. Some LP were given RN, but not all; this possibly dependent on sentence length.

Note: neither addressee nor signatory names are listed in this Index: see the Addressee Index (page 6) or Signatory Index (page 17).
