Names Index

Titles without names have not been indexed.

Many names in the Letters lack initials or given names.
Idiosyncratic spelling and poor writing add to identification difficulties.
Initials and convict RN (Register Numbers) have been ascribed where possible, although most RN are given in the Letters.
Names in *italics* are those who appear to be convicts or prisoners.
Names in normal type are of settlers, soldiers or government staff.
Some convicts (in *italics*) were employed by Government and received freedom or pardon. These convicts may appear in both normal type and italics.
Convicts known to have received a Conditional Pardon are in Italics with RN.
Names with an * are included in Barker, J (see page 47).
Absence of initials or RN means identification is uncertain or unknown without further enquiry.

The names of some convicts do not appear in the lists of the transported.
These RN have 'nt' against them, meaning 'not in the transportation lists'.

All identifications should be carefully checked. Especially

1. the same name with an entry in both italics and in normal type.
2. the same name with an entry with initials and an entry without them.
