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Introduction

There are 1118 Correspondence Register Subject Numbers (CRSN) within Accession 1156 Item C 50, each with correspondence abstracts.

Each subject has a different sequential number on the left head of a page (or mid-page where one page has two subjects or more). The subject of each CRSN is at the right head of a page (or section of a page). A place of 'origin' for the first of the correspondence abstracts of each subject is placed next to the CRSN — though the place so written often has little significance for the ensuing correspondence.

The CRSN commence at 7340 and conclude at 8773 — an apparent total of 1434 headings. However, 9 CRS numbers are repeated, marked in this Index as "A", but with an "a" in the original. The CSRN 8772 is missing. These modifications result in a total of 1442 CRSN.

The subjects relate to matters that came within the purview of the Comptroller-General of Convicts: matters outside his jurisdiction are not recorded in C 50. Consequently letter abstracts do not show all the material relating to any subject matter, particularly in the case of persons. For example, the correspondence abstracts of a CRSN for an individual may first record the granting of a Conditional Pardon, but the next entry (some time later) may be a request for a Ticket of Leave. The events leading to the loss of the Conditional Pardon and re-entry to the supervision of the Convict Establishment are not recorded — belonging to the Police or legal areas.

CSRN subjects that are not persons are listed in the Subject Index on page 6.

Subjects with a CSRN that are a person (or persons) are placed within the Names Index on page 56 (and not in the Subject Index). In the Names Index the CSRN of such person 'subjects' are shown in **Bold Type** — to distinguish them from those persons whose names appear in the letter abstracts but are not a subject. 'Non-subject persons' are shown in the Names Index in normal or plain type.

Consequently the Persons Index displays individuals with CSRN in both bold and plain type, showing such persons to be in the Correspondence Register as a Subject (in bold) and also mentioned in abstract/s of correspondence (in normal type). Only one CSRN entry (in bold or plain type) is given for each person, though a name may be entered several times in the letter abstracts of a CSRN.

Each of the 1442 CSRN lists the persons between whom letters are exchanged, the date of each and an abstract of the letter concerned. These interchanges of letters are 'grouped' with a sequential number: these internal sequence numbers are not used in the Index. Where names are written in the letter interchange column they are given in the Names Index. Position Titles are not indexed.

The C 50 Correspondence Register commences on 12 April 1866 — a date prior to the earliest entry in C 49. Some CSRN comprise the abstract of a single letter. By contrast, many CSRN cover a number of years (the maximum being 36 years), and are written over several pages, with total abstracts exceeding 100.

Given the sheer volume of letter abstracts, many of which are requests for basic information and a response thereto, an index reference to every abstract would make the Index unwieldy in size, as well as involving much material of minor significance. To keep the Index of reasonable size, the Theme-topic Index (page 27) has required choice of material, inevitably a subjective one. Consequently the Theme-topic Index comprises an informed selection from the total material in the abstracts, chosen (hopefully) to guide to and reflect all the important matters, events and issues.

Unfortunately the writing of the clerks entering the abstract entries is very poor in many instances, at times verging on the impossible and great care needs be exercised in deciphering the writing.

Subjects, especially those not of persons, are not always followed by abstracts that reflect the initial Subject. After a single or a few entries a new (not clearly related) matter may be introduced and be continued. However, the Theme-topic index (page 27) enables these different matters to be found.

Few of the Theme-Topics have been cross-referenced. If (as an example) a Resident Magistrate orders the Police to escort a trade convict to a Road Party to repair a bridge, all the underlined words appear as Themes in the Theme-Topic Index. Consequently choice has been made as to which Theme appears to best meet the content or Topic of the letter abstract concerned.

Subjects Index

have been ascribed where possible, though most RN are given in the CRSN abstracts.

Local Prisoners did not always receive an RN — possibly depending on the nature of the offence.

Where the abstracts refer to a local convict without a RN this is shown in the Index below.

The frequent errors of spelling, initials and RN have been corrected where possible.

Names in *italics* are those who appear to be convicts or prisoners.

Convicts known to have had more than one Register Number have all their RN shown

although not all such RN are used in C 50.

CR Subject Numbers in **bold** indicate a person is the subject for the abstract entries of the Number.

CR Subject Numbers in plain type indicate a person is named in the abstracts of the Subject Number.

Consequently a name may have a CRSN in both normal and bold type.

Names may be mentioned more than once in any abstract series but only one entry is made below.

Absence of initials or convict RN means identification is uncertain or unknown without further enquiry.

All identifications should be carefully checked. Especially

the same name having an entry with initials and an entry without them.
