

Robert Marcum, 2055, *Robert Small*

6789. Robert Marcum, 18, pawning shoes and stealing goods, committed 8 November 1848, tried at Magistrates Petty Sessions, guilty, one month hard labour or £1 and one month hard labour, discharged 3 January 1849.

1155. Robert Marcum, 18, stealing sheep, committed 27 February 1850, convicted Mallow April Sessions, guilty, 6 months hard labour, once before in gaol, R&W, discharged 21 September 1850. He was in Cork Gaol from 6 April to 21 September 1850.

Friday 13 December 1850, Robert Marcum, stealing bread, was sent to Kanturk Sessions. 41 prisoners, 26 males and 15 females, were sent in 4 carts to the railway station and transmitted to Kanturk.

20 December 1850, Robert Marcum, highway robbery, sentenced to 10 years, was received at Cork Gaol from Kanturk.

5496. Robert Marcum, 20, robbery and stealing bread, committed 16 October 1850, convicted Kanturk December Sessions, guilty, sentenced to 10 years, R&W, once in gaol before, sent to Constabulary for Spike Island on 20 August 1851.
