

Patrick Tighe, 2535 Phoebe Dunbar

Police Court, Adelaide

3 August 1857

Drunk and Disorderly.—Patrick Tighe, Joseph McCoy, and Hugh Smith, were fined 10s, each; and Joseph Higgs, and Robert Moor, 5s, each, for being drunk in various parts of the city, on Saturday night.

Adelaide Times (SA : 1848 - 1858), Mon 3 Aug 1857, p3

Goal Register: said he came to Adelaide from the Swan River in **1855**. He was 30 years old, could read & write, single, catholic and a labourer. Fined 10s or 7 days.

7 September 1857

Disorderly — Patrick Tighe was fined £1 for being drunk and using obscene language in Hindley-street, on Sunday evening.

South Australian Register (Adelaide, SA : 1839 - 1900), Tue 8 Sep 1857, p3

Gaol Register: 'as before'. Fined 20s or 14 days.

There are numerous newspaper reports of Patrick Tighe being drunk or using abusive language. In 1872 he must have tried to get into the Destitute Asylum

And again in 1874.

Patrick Tighe, of Adelaide, laborer, was charged by Joseph Lucas, wards man, with wantonly disturbing the inmates of the Destitute Asylum by ringing the door bell without lawful cause. The defendant applied to the Asylum for admission' at a late hour one evening, and was told to call again the next day, He would not go away, but kept ringing the bell, thus disturbing the inmates. Fined. 10s

Date of arrival varied in the records.

4 April 1860: Arrived 1854

10 June 1865: Arrived 1855

16 May 1851: Arrived 1858

Yatala Prison records in 1860: Patrick said he came to Adelaide on the *Sarah* in 1855.

Same day—The schooner Sarah, 54 tons, Christien, from Swan River the 28th October. Acraman, Main, Lindsay, & Co., agents. Passengers—Andrew Gordon, Andrew Brophy, G. Goode, P. Tighr, J. Craig, W. Parker, C. Goode, and M. A. Anderson.
